Main Idea: Because Jesus did not meet John's expectations of what Messiah would do, he struggled with doubt and confusion about Jesus' identity as the Christ.

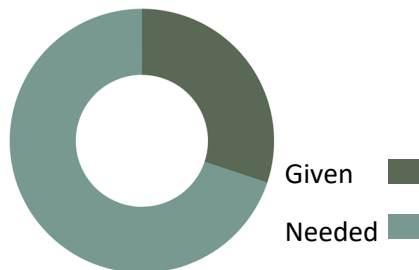
