"GOD'S WORD: BETTER THAN EVER"

Matthew 5:17-20

Main Idea: With the advent of the kingdom and the arrival of the King, the Old Testament, down to the smallest detail, not only remains authoritative and valid, but has a much deeper application.

The relationship of Jesus and the OT (17)

He did not come to abolish it

He came to fulfill it

By fulfilling prophetic <u>predictions</u>

By completing the sacrificial system

By clarifying its *intended* meaning and goal

By obeying it perfectly

The binding validity of the OT (18-19)

Every letter and detail has lasting relevance (18)

Every letter and detail is binding (19)

Those who are <u>careless</u> with God's commands will be dishonored

Those who are <u>careful</u> with God's commands will be <u>honored</u>

The righteousness demanded by the OT (20)

It must exceed that of the Scribes and Pharisees

It is a requirement for kingdom admission

Principles to affirm about the OT

The OT reveals a standard of God's perfect righteousness

The OT is a revelation of God's will for humanity

The OT was given, in part, to reveal humanity's perilous spiritual predicament, and then lead them to a Savior who is qualified to rescue them because of His perfect obedience

Jesus is the Interpreter of the law who determines what are binding commands and what are temporary rituals
