Main Idea: No one can know God or Jesus without their enablement.

Jesus praises His Father for His sovereign revelation (25-26)

Father hides the truth from those whom we would expect to know it

The meaning of “the wise and understanding”

Attitudes that prevent true understanding

Father reveals the truth to those whom we would expect not to know it

Metaphor of “little children”

Attitudes that enable true understanding

The Father delegates His sovereignty to His Son (27)

The exclusive relationship between Father and Son

The exclusive knowledge shared by Father and Son

Only the Father knows the Son

Only the Son knows the Father

Only the Son can reveal the Father
