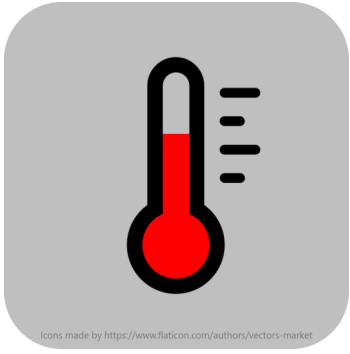


TEMPORARY REQUIREMENTS

for Emmanuel Bible Church facilities



Those who are sick (or have been exposed to symptoms) must not participate in in-person gatherings

Please stay home if you have had or have been exposed to COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, etc.) in the last 14 days. Please consider ways to creatively include those who must stay home through technology (phone, online meeting platforms, etc.).



Physical/Social Distancing of 6' must be maintained between people (including kids) from different households or parties

A party consists of those who choose to come together and may not exceed 6, unless they are all part of the same household.



Please practice good hygiene

- Wash your hands often with soap and water.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or sleeve when coughing or sneezing.



We recommend (but do not require) that individuals at risk for severe complications (age related or have underlying medical conditions) stay home

And continue connecting by phone, online meeting platforms, etc. For those of us who can begin meeting, let's consider how we can care for, encourage, and assist those who cannot gather.



Masks, face shields, or face coverings are required

unless an accommodation or exemption is required by law or one of the following exemptions apply...

- Children under 5 years of age.
- Anyone with a medical condition that makes it hard to breathe when wearing a mask, face shield, or face covering.
- Anyone who has a disability that prevents them from wearing a mask, face shield, or face covering.
- Employees, contractors and volunteers when at or in a location where they are not interacting with the public (attendees, visitors, etc.) and 6' or more of distance can be maintained between other people.

Please note: masks, face shields, and face coverings should NOT be worn by children under age 2 or anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.
