WHAT

Pastor Stan will be on a leave of absence, for health purposes, from July 3 - October 3.

WHY

This July is Pastor Stan's 20th anniversary as Senior Pastor at Emmanuel Bible Church. During that time he has served faithfully and carried an incredible load, especially in the areas of preaching and counseling. Pastor Stan has a loving shepherd's heart, he isn't very good at saying "no", and he can't help but care deeply. This has all led to a place of deep physical exhaustion.

Over the last few months, Pastor Stan has been experiencing a number of symptoms that have caused great concern. He has consulted with a number of doctors, has undergone tests, and will continue to undergo further examination. This is a serious condition that must not be ignored and that requires an extended time of rest.
